

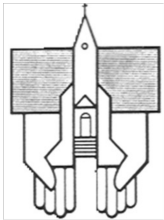
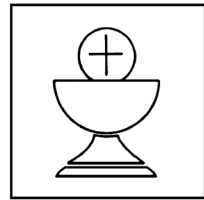

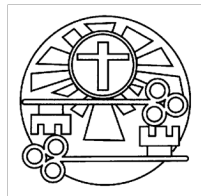

Our practice of closed communion is the historic practice of the church. It is prompted by love, both for God's Word and for God's people. It does not deny that members of other denominations are Christians. Rather, it bows the knee to the Bible's deep concern for doctrinal truth (Rom. 16:17) and the Bible's witness that doctrinal unity is central to the common reception of this sacrament. **For this reason, guests who desire to commune are asked to speak with the pastor before the service.**



**WELCOME!** We invite all visitors to sign the guest register in the narthex and worship with us again. If you are not a first time visitor and are not communing, please complete the card located with communion cards in front of the pews. If you have questions about how to join our church or study the Scriptures with us, please speak with one of our Elders or the Pastor.

Each Saturday evening from 6-8PM Pastor Rappe avails himself for private confession and absolution, that which the historical Lutheran Church refers to as the third Sacrament. This is made available to those whose consciences are burdened and whose hearts are troubled. No one is forced to make private confession, as no one is forced to Baptism or the Holy Supper. Rather, this is the means of God's gospel to those who seek Him and the forgiveness of sins in Jesus.

## HOLY GOSPEL

**LUKE 1:39-55**

**Mary, The Mother Of Our Lord-August 15th:** According to Scrip-  
tures, Mary was present at all of the important events of her Son's  
life: in the birth cycle, at the miracle at Canna, at the cross, at the  
tomb, with the apostles after the ascension waiting for the Spirit. Ex-  
cept for traditions, nothing is known of her parentage or the place or  
date of her death. August 15 has been observed since early times as  
the day of what the Eastern church calls her "falling asleep," i.e., her  
death. Luther retained a special affection for Mary and wrote a splen-  
did exposition of the Magnificat. The other days on the calendar asso-  
ciated with Mary — The Presentation of Our Lord, The Annunciation  
of Our Lord, The Visitation are festivals of our Lord Jesus Christ.
