

Each Saturday evening from 6-8PM Pastor Rappe avails himself for private confession and absolution, that which the historical Lutheran Church refers to as the third Sacrament. This is made available to those whose consciences are burdened and whose hearts are troubled. No one is forced to make private confession, as no one is forced to Baptism or the Holy Supper. Rather, this is the means of God's gospel to those who seek Him and the forgiveness of sins in Jesus.



<u>Mary, The Mother Of Our Lord-August 15th:</u> According to Scriptures, Mary was present at all of the important events of her Son's life: in the birth cycle, at the miracle at Canna, at the cross, at the tomb, with the apostles after the ascension waiting for the Spirit. Except for traditions, nothing is known of her parentage or the place or date of her death. August 15 has been observed since early times as the day of what the Eastern church calls her "falling asleep," i.e., her death. Luther retained a special affection for Mary and wrote a splendid exposition of the Magnificat. The other days on the calendar associated with Mary — The Presentation of Our Lord, The Annunciation of Our Lord, The Visitation are festivals of our Lord Jesus Christ.

NURSERY ROOM is available for children under 5 years of age who are having difficulty the service. There is also a rocking chair in the room. The room also has speakers in it to hear the service.


