

ST JAMES THE ELDER, APOSTLE-JULY 25

James, a fisherman, son of Zebedee and brother of John, is the only apostle whose martyrdom is recorded in scripture (Acts 12:2). He was beheaded by Herod Agrippa near Easter in 43 or 44, and the Eastern Church he has been commemorated on dates near Easter. In the ninth century his relics were believed to have been moved to Compostela in Spain, and that shrine was a popular place of pilgrimage in the Middle Ages.
